Recreating Safely Near Dams

This year's snowpack is expected to increase flows of cold rushing water. Water levels may change rapidly and cause dangerous conditions.

BE PREPARED – Be aware of swift rising cold water. Watch for these signs:

Faster moving water

Intensified sounds of rushing water

Previously exposed rocks and debris now submerged

Increased difficulty wading in water

Colder than normal water temperatures even on warm days

SHARE THESE TIPS TO HELP KEEP EVERYONE SAFE:

- Obey all signage and siren warnings
- If flows in the river or creek are rising rapidly, go to higher ground and stay there until flows recede
- Do not attempt to walk or drive through rushing water
- Call 911 for help
