Subject: Lee Vining Hydroelectric Project (FERC Project No. 1388) Draft License Application

Dear Acting Secretary Reese:

Southern California Edison (SCE) hereby files with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) this Draft License Application (DLA) for a new license for the relicensing of the Lee Vining Hydroelectric Project (Project) (FERC Project No. 1388). The Project is in Mono County, California, on both Lee Vining and Glacier Creeks. The current license issued by FERC on February 4, 1997, expires on January 31, 2027. All enclosed public documents will be available on SCE's Project website (<https://www.sce.com/leevining>) in addition to the FERC eLibrary.

SCE has prepared this DLA in accordance with the Traditional Licensing Process, as approved by FERC on October 8, 2021, and the application content requirements of the Code of Federal Regulations, Title 18, Section 4.51 (18 CFR § 4.51), *Application for License for Major Project—Existing Dam*. Included herein are draft technical exhibits (Exhibit A, B, C, D, F, G, and H) and a draft environmental report (Exhibit E). Please note that the draft Exhibit F (Design Drawings) and one-line diagram contain Controlled Unclassified Information (CUI) and Critical Energy Infrastructure Information (CEII). This information contains sensitive and detailed engineering information that, if used incorrectly, may compromise the safety of the Project and those responsible for its proper operation. These documents were filed electronically with FERC under the "CEII tab" and are marked as "CUI//CEII—Contains Critical Energy/Electric Infrastructure Information—DO NOT RELEASE" in accordance with instructions issued by FERC.¹ SCE requests that Exhibit F and the one-line diagram be maintained in a non-public file and withheld from public disclosure in accordance with applicable regulations.

This DLA discusses SCE's proposal for continued operation and maintenance of the Project. Exhibit E includes the results of studies undertaken in support of the relicensing. Discussion in Exhibit E considers how the information and data collected during the studies addresses issues raised by agencies and other interested parties, and how the

information collected informs SCE's proposed Project operations. As appropriate, Exhibit E includes SCE's preliminary proposals for protection, mitigation, and enhancement (PME) measures to address Project effects (ongoing and proposed) on environmental and social resources. SCE intends to continue discussing PME measures with Stakeholders after the DLA filing and will include final measures, including any proposed management plan(s), as part of the Final License Application (FLA).

Due to weather and recreation facility closures in 2023, the Recreation Use Assessment (REC-1) is ongoing as of the filing of this DLA, and the Draft Technical Report will be submitted with the FLA.

The DLA is being filed in five volumes as described below and includes the following exhibits describing Project resources:

There are no portions of Exhibit E that reveal privileged, confidential cultural or Tribal resources information. Volume V of the DLA contains Draft Technical Study Reports for cultural resources, which contain information regarding sensitive cultural resources and therefore qualifies as confidential information under 36 CFR § 800.11(c)(1). Disclosure of such information could be harmful to these resources. Volume V was filed electronically with FERC under the "privileged tab" and is marked as "CUI//PRIV—Contains Confidential Information—DO NOT RELEASE" in accordance with instructions issued by FERC.² Because this information is statutorily designated as confidential³ and exempt from public disclosure under the Freedom of Information Act,⁴ SCE requests that Volume V be maintained in a non-public file and withheld from public disclosure in accordance with applicable regulations. The Tribal Resource (TRI-1) Study is ongoing, and the Draft Technical Report will be filed as confidential and privileged with the FLA.

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Additionally, SCE is developing a Historic Properties Management Plan (HPMP) that will be circulated to the State Historic Preservation Office, Tribal interested parties, and relevant agency representatives; the final HPMP will be included with the FLA.

In accordance with 18 CFR § 16.8 (c)(5), formal written comments specifically in reference to the DLA are due within 90 days of the date of this filing (November 25, 2024). Comments may be filed via the FERC eLibrary.
